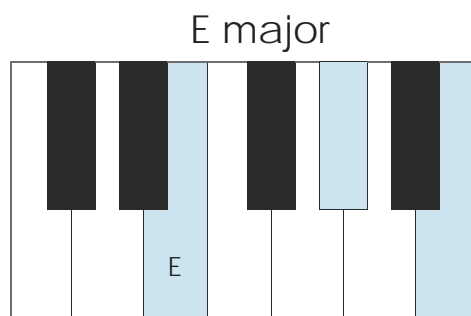
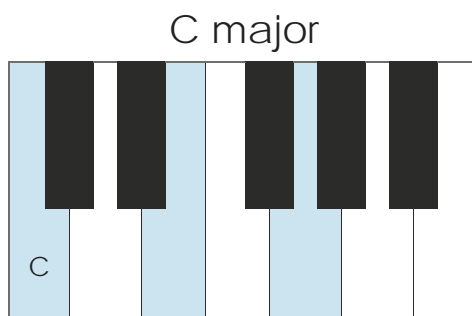


Chords (Triads)

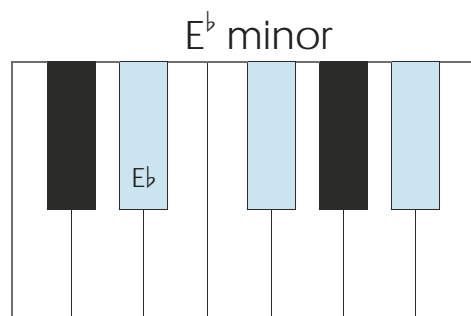
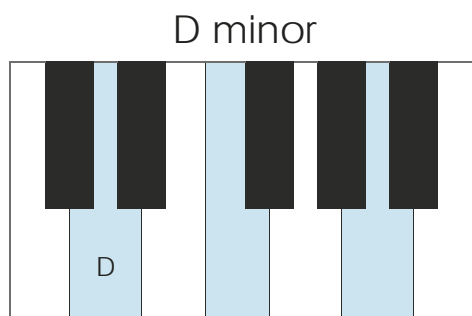
Triads are chords with just 3 notes, and there's just 4 main types: major, minor, augmented, and diminished.

The beginning note determines the name of the chord.

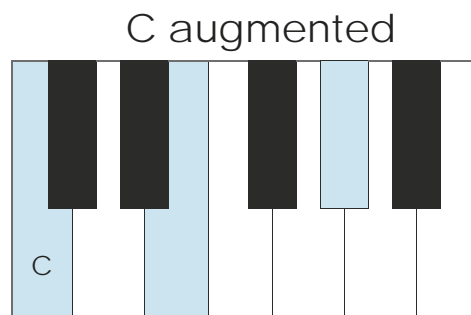
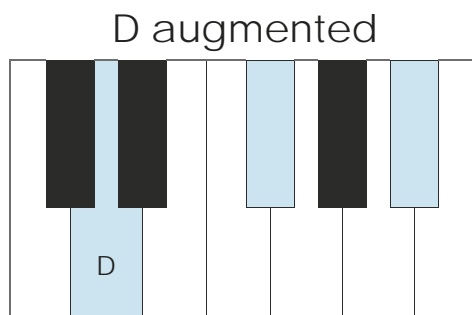
Major chords are built by taking any starting note, going up 4 half-steps, then 3 half-steps:



Minor chords are built by taking any starting note, going up 3 half-steps, then 4 half-steps:



Augmented chords are built by taking any starting note, going up 4 half-steps, then 4 half-steps again:



Diminished chords are built by taking any starting note, going up 3 half-steps, then 3 half-steps again:
